Our Program

The Presbyterian Preschool uses a center-based program with theme activities. Our curriculum centers include literature, math, art, pre-writing, and science.

Skill Development

Our activity room provides students with the opportunity for independent thinking and choice making. Social skills are developed as students learn through play. A computer lab reinforces skills taught in the classroom.



Lunch Bunch (optional)

Lunch Bunch is offered each Thursday until 1:30pm for an additional fee of \$5/week. This time provides students with the opportunity for extra development of social skills and learning to be more independent.

Enrichment Opportunities

Enrichment is added through special music with Peggy Coppler, Christian Education, visits to the public library, and gross motor development with an outdoor playground and an indoor gym.

Music with Miss Peggy

Our Pre-K students meet weekly with Miss Peggy throughout the year, while the 3-year-olds begin in the spring. Peggy is fully certified in Musikgarten curriculum and brings those skills to our classes here at Presbyterian Preschool.

Godly Play

We use a Montessori-based Christian Education curriculum called Godly Play. This program encourages children to think about faith and God on their own and encourages them to ask questions to build a strong and personal relationship with God.

Wabash Carnegie Public Library

Each Friday, we walk to the library for Story Time, puppet shows, and crafts.

Two Class Options

Pre-Kindergarten Class

- Age requirement:
Must be 4 years old by August 1st
- Class meets:
Four days a week
Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
- Maximum enrollment: 18 students
- Monthly Tuition:
\$80 (\$720 for the year)



Three-Year-Old Class

- Age requirement:
Must be 3 years old by August 1st and must be toilet trained before classes begin
- Class meets:
Two days a week
Thursday and Friday
- Maximum enrollment: 12 students
- Monthly Tuition:
\$60 (\$540 for the year)
